ACCOMMODATION

The Rooms and Suites are decorated in a contemporary, Asian-inspired style, with noble and natural materials, to offer comfort, well-being, elegance and harmony.

The **Sofitel Imperial Resort & Spa** totals 191 rooms and suites as follows:

- **143 Luxury rooms** of 50m, either on the ground floor with garden view but sea-facing or sea-facing at the 1st and 2nd floors. They can accommodate up to 2 adults and 1 child.
- **42 Prestige Suites** with garden view of 75m² nestled amidst nature away from the main building, offering privacy. These rooms count a terrace on the same level and a balcony with a superb view on the Japanese Imperial garden and its waterfalls.
